Evaluation Methods Used:

A sample set of pages, modal dialogs, components and email templates were identified to perform the audit on RR General Testing, RR Single Page UI Testing and RR Urdu Testing platforms. Some question type pages such as "Database", " Scan QR Code" and "Codelysis" designed to be displayed on desktop browsers are not optimized for mobile browsing. As a result, the content of these pages do not reflow at 320*256 viewport size. Mercer Mettl plans to educate its customers about accessibility challenges associated with a question image and will advise them not to use such question image. Mercer Mettl plans to include recommendations for their customers to define secondary language programmatically using "lang" attribute to ensure assistive technologies can render the content accurately for their users.
